GIVE THANKS: for our Salvation!

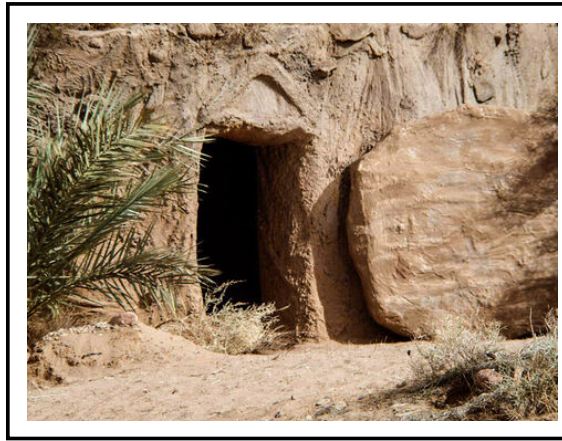
PLEASE PRAY:
