while your anchor holds within the veil.

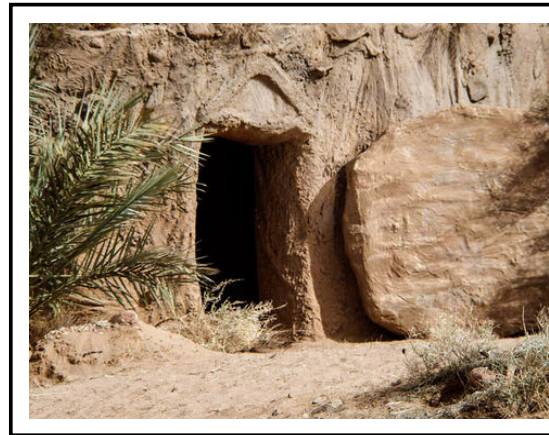
Will your eyes behold
