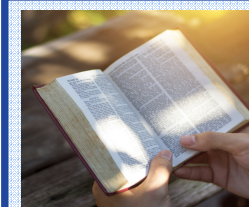
- for the Trustees meeting held on Thursday and for the guidance of the Holy Spirit in that meeting;
