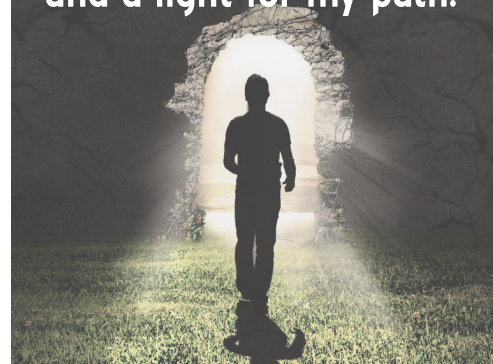


The Quarry Gospel Church Sunday 19th April
