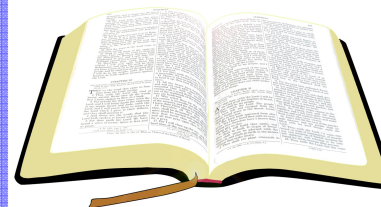
I LONG TO BE THE BRIDE
