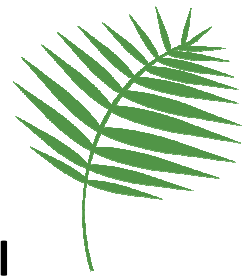

For it is Christ we're serving.

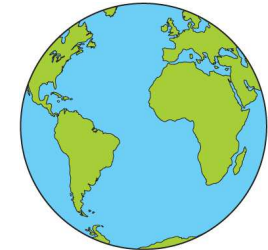
